

Greg Raymer to Highlight Advocacy Efforts at the Annual Conservative Political Action Conference

Washington, DC (February 16, 2010) –The Poker Players Alliance (PPA), the leading poker grassroots advocacy group with more than one million members nationwide, will be a booth-sponsor at the annual Conservative Political Action Conference (CPAC) this Thursday through Saturday in Washington, D.C. This will be the second year PPA has attended CPAC and used the conference as an opportunity to increase its advocacy with conservative audiences and make the case for supporting poker player's rights.

Greg "Fossilman" Raymer, the 2004 World Series of Poker champion, will participate in an autograph signing session for attendees on Thursday and conduct interviews with conservative bloggers and talk radio hosts. "Americans enjoy the game of poker no matter their political stripes," Raymer said.
